Our intent is for the new construction to match our current school in both quality of materials and overall design without being extravagant or incorporating unnecessary square footage or features. The plan provides quality spaces for learning and provides learning opportunities that are not currently possible

While no one can predict the future, current market conditions are financially favorable to address long-term needs of the district. Interest rates are at a historic low. These low interest rates will reduce monthly payments and reduce tax impact. We are also fortunate to be a debt free district, are financially strong, and experiencing steady increased enrollment. It's important that we look forward as a community. The need to improve our facilities has been a topic of discussion for many years. Our needs will not go away and construction costs will continue to increase each year.
