



WISCONSIN HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (WHEAP)

What is WHEAP? It is a program that provides assistance for heating costs, electric costs, and energy crisis situations. WHEAP provides assistance to households across the state to help lower the burden incurred with monthly energy costs.

How is it funded? Funded by Federal and State funds.

Eligible fuel types? Wood, propane, natural gas, electricity, or fuel oil to heat your home.

WHO is ELIGIBLE? Your household may be eligible for WHEAP services based on a number of factors. However, if the gross income for your household income falls into the guidelines below, you *may* qualify.
