

**School District of Shell Lake
Regular Board Meeting
July 18, 2016**

President Stu Olson called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

School Board members present were Stu Olson, Steve Naglosky, Scott Smith, Pat Pesko, Joel Anderson, Linda Nielsen and Nicole Tims. Also present were David Bridenhagen, Heather Cox, Laura Stunkel, Phyllis Mayala, Lori Hanson-Hungerbuhler, Danielle Danford, Sabrina Naglosky, Tiffany Schroeder, Rich and Laura Taylor and Paul Christel.

For public comments, Rich Taylor spoke about his experience as an assistant basketball coach for the past 5 years.

Tiffany Schroeder and Sabrina Naglosky spoke about the P.T.A. and the various events that have happened this year. They presented three checks to the School Board; \$3000 to go towards Wolf Ridge, \$1,000 for the AODA program, and \$800 towards an anti-bullying campaign at the elementary school.
