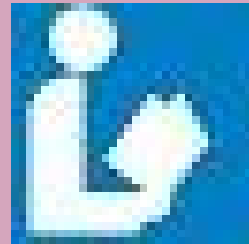

Invasive Species Inspectors:

Primary responsibilities include, inspecting watercraft at Shell Lake and Round Lake landings, removing and disposing of debris, collecting and recording information, educating the public and collecting the launch fee. Salary is \$8.47 per hour. Some courses on aquatic invasive species preferred.
