6. Click "select time" for the time slot you wish to choose.
7. View and confirm the correct time. Click "Save"
8. When finished, you may click "Print All Scheduled Conferences" to print a copy of your scheduled conference(s).
9. You will receive an email confirmation if you have an email on file with the school district.

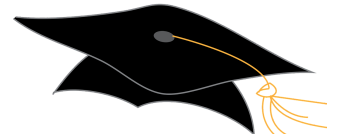
