Time slots will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

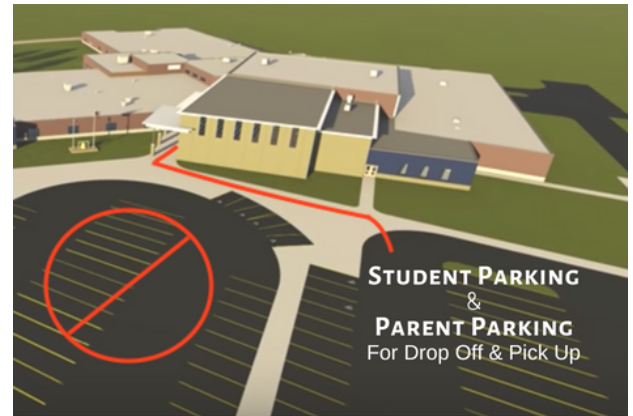
Online scheduling will open starting January 5th. Please complete no later than Monday, January 19th.
