Driver's Ed

This summer's Driver's Education Program will be held the following days during the summer of 2019: June 10-14, June 17 - 21, June 24 - 28, July 1-3, (make-up days). There will be two sections offered this summer: 8:00 a.m.-10:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m.

Students may begin to enroll during the week of January 14, 2019. The current fee for the whole program is \$275.00 per student (subject to change), and includes the 6 hours of driving, and 6 hours of observation in order to fulfill the state requirements. The driving is done either before or after the school day once the student has earned their permit. Students must attend every day for all 15 days of the summer classes. If students miss any of the days (maximum of three days absences are allowed), they must make up their time during July 1-3. Students must be in attendance for the 15 days, to get their driver's license. In order for your child to enroll in the Summer Driver's Education Program, we are requiring a signature from the student, and parent/legal guardian. This signed form must be returned prior to the student being allowed to enroll in this class. Your signature on this form indicates that you understand the above guidelines, and give permission to your son/daughter to participate in the 2019 Summer Driver's Education Course.
