4K Registration Day for the 2018-19 school year



Join us for a fun morning at Shell Lake Primary on Friday March 23, 2018 from 8:30-12:00! Meet the teaching staff, complete necessary enrollment paperwork, and explore your child's learning environment with them! Plan to spend about an hour meeting with the teacher and completing a developmental questionnaire with your child. Community agencies will be available to provide additional information about their programs. Registration for the 2018-2019 school year is open to any child who will be 4 before September 1, 2018 and want to enroll in the 4K program for the 2018-19 school year.
