

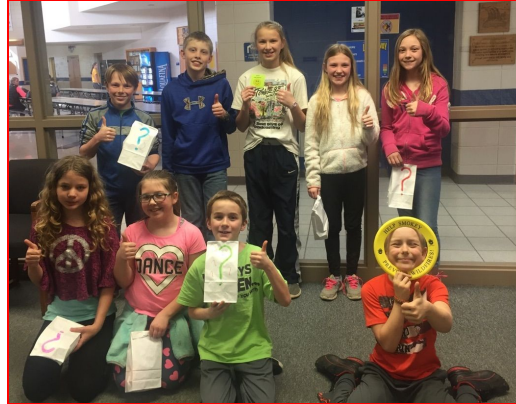

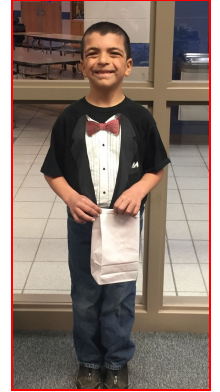

### News From FFA

Career Development results - two teams are going to State! The livestock judging and poultry judging team qualified in the top 25% to go to state in Madison on April 28th.

- Livestock competed at UWRF on Saturday, April 1. They finished 8th overall out of 35 teams and 117 individuals. Top scorer was Isaac Hopke (24) followed by Alecia Knoop (35), Dominic Hopke (37) and Madeline Hopke (40).
- Poultry competed at FVTC on Friday, March 31. They finished 4th overall out of 20 teams. Top place individual was Cassie Skattebo-10th, followed by Christopher Lord-13, Ben Nelson-21 and Josh Wistrom-54.
- Dairy cattle competed at FVTC, finishing 17th out of 40 teams. Top individual scoring was Katie Crosby-25, followed by Megan Anderson, Alecia Knoop and Gene Quam.
- Horse Team competed at UWRF finishing 17 out of 33 teams. Top individual scorer was Jerney Meister followed by Katie Crosby, Ashlea Meister and Clare Walker.

- Veterinary Science finished 18th overall. Top individual scorer was Kayli Marschall finishing 34 followed by Sydney Schunck, Cassie Skattebo and Jordyn Monson.
- Middle School Agriscience team finished 13 overall. Top individual Mikenzi Miller-34 followed by Stephanie Carrillo and Lilly Edline. Only 5 points separated these three. They placed extremely well as a team.
- Forestry team finished 7 overall out of 12 teams. Top individual scorer was Marty Anderson-9, followed by Megan Anderson-18, SEth Symond and Joe Uchtyl tied-30.

With the new statewide issuance law now in effect, if the vital record you are requesting falls within the dates listed below, you can obtain the copies from ANY Register of Deeds office in the State of Wisconsin:

Records available for statewide issuance:

Birth Certificates - from 10/1/1907 to present

Death Certificates - from 9/1/2013 to present

Marriage Certificates - 6/2/2015 to present

Divorce Certificates - 1/1/2016 to present

\*\*\*FOR OFFICE WALK INS: Due to the change in how our office now obtains vital records, it may take 15 to 20 minutes to receive a copy of the requested record in person.
