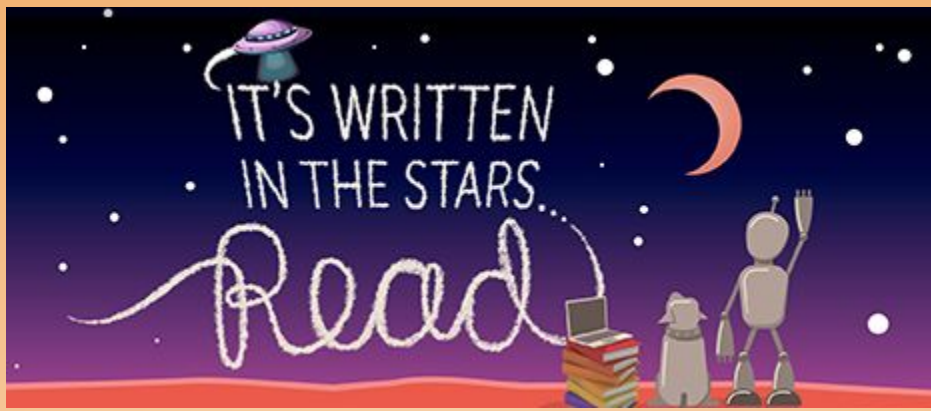

Calling all 7 -12th grade students!

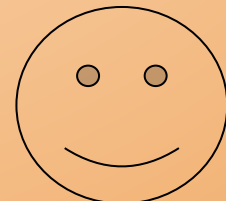
Show off our creative flair!
