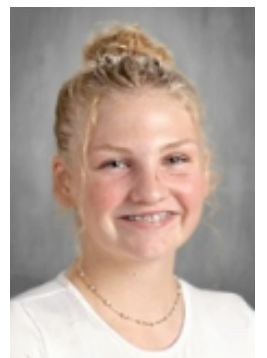

Individuals placing were: Alivia Marker - 3rd, Kasey Schrankel- 6th, Andrew Imrick - 7th



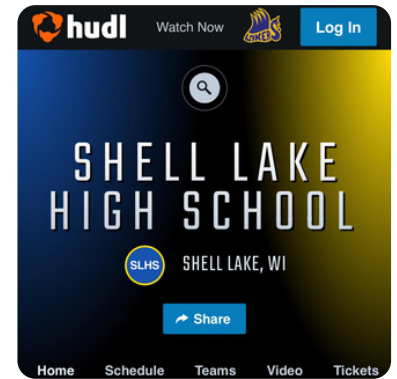

## November 2024 Referendum [LEARN MORE](#) →

### What does the ballot language say?

Shall the School Board of the School District of Shell Lake be authorized to exceed the revenue limit under Section 121.91 of the Wisconsin Statutes beginning with the 2025-26 school year through the 2028-29 school year on a non-recurring basis by the following amounts for the purpose of paying expenses related to ongoing operational costs to include maintaining educational programming, educational resources, staffing and maintenance needs as follows: \$650,000 for the 2025-26 school year, \$935,000 for the 2026-27 school year, \$1,200,000 for the 2027-28 school year and \$1,475,000 for the 2028-29 school year as provided in the foregoing resolution?


