




The After School Program is an educational enrichment program for Lakers in grades 4K-6th! Details regarding dates and pick up times can be found in the registration form:



LITERACY INSIGHTS **Fall 2024**

Shell Lake School District

What is ACT 20?

Wisconsin Act 20 is a new law from 2023 that requires schools in Wisconsin to provide science-based early literacy instruction for students in grades 4K to 3rd grade. The goal of this law is to help improve reading and literacy skills for our children by making sure they get the support they need to become strong readers. The law will take effect January 2025.

Good news! Shell Lake Elementary has been working on these things for the past few years! Here is what you can expect for your 4K-3rd Grade students:

Curriculum

Shell Lake Elementary adopted Amplify Core Knowledge & Language Arts in 2021. The Early Literacy Curriculum Council recommends this curriculum and it is approved by the WI DPI.

Personalized Reading Plans

Personalized reading plans will focus on addressing literacy skill gaps, setting student goals and benchmarks for achieving grade-level literacy, and will incorporate an intervention strategy along with a progress monitoring plan.

Assessment

All Wisconsin students in grades 4K-3rd grades will be assessed using the an early reading readiness screener. Results of the screener will be shared with families within 15 days.

Students that score below the 25% tile on the screener will receive additional testing to determine specific areas of reading difficulty.
