

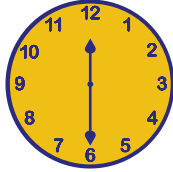

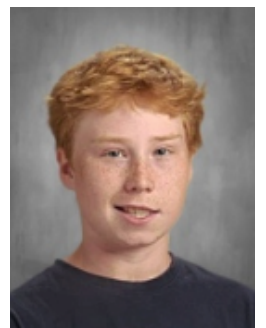
The food pantry is available to any family who have students within the Shell Lake School District.

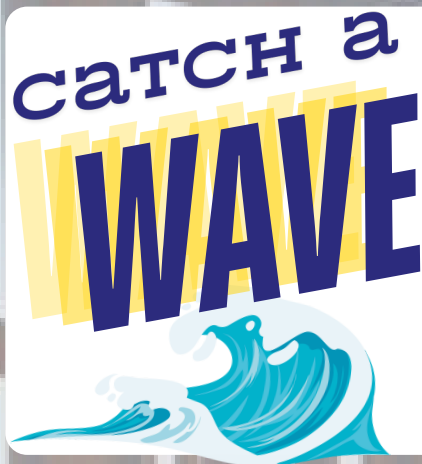

We invite you to complete 31 self-care activities—one for each day of the month.

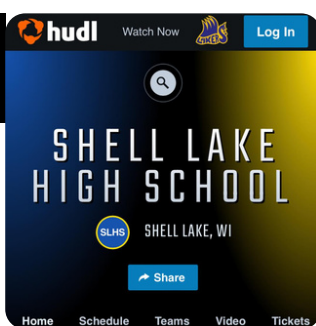
- Begin with a mindful minute or a positive affirmation to kickstart your day.
