

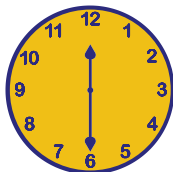

He displays leadership qualities in the classroom as he consistently volunteers, leads class discussion, and asks thought-provoking questions. And, he has a great sense of humor!

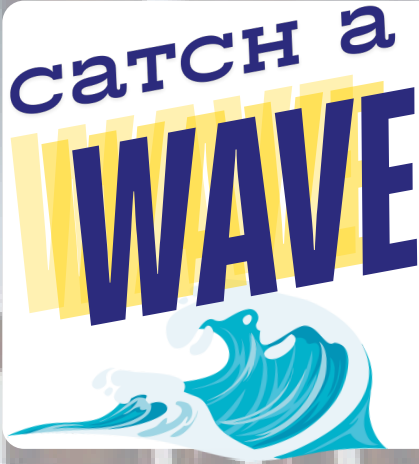

- Let's make wellness a daily focus this October!

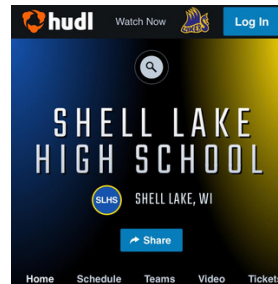

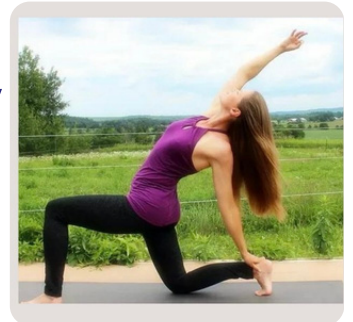

## November 2024 Referendum

On November 5, 2024, the School District of Shell Lake will ask residents to vote on a four-year, non-recurring operating referendum, authorizing the District to exceed the revenue limit.

Shell Lake is a great place to live, work, and raise a family. The support our community provides to our school district is second to none. While we are proud of our successes, we also know there is more to do to best prepare our students for their future. This operating referendum will help ensure we are able to maintain the quality and diversity of our educational and extracurricular programs that our students, families, and community have come to expect.

### Referendum Language

Shall the School Board of the School District of Shell Lake be authorized to exceed the revenue limit under Section 121.91 of the Wisconsin Statutes beginning with the 2025-26 school year through the 2028-29 school year on a non-recurring basis by the following amounts for the purpose of paying expenses related to ongoing operational costs to include maintaining educational programming, educational resources, staffing and maintenance needs as follows: \$650,000 for the 2025-26 school year, \$935,000 for the 2026-27 school year, \$1,200,000 for the 2027-28 school year and \$1,475,000 for the 2028-29 school year as provided in the foregoing resolution?

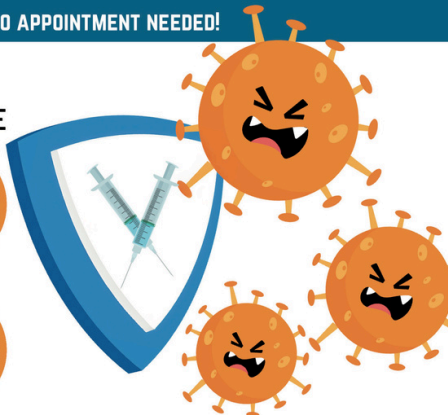
