School District of Shell Lake Food Pantry

The Shell Lake School District is teaming up with Feed My People to offer a food pantry at school. With the cost of groceries steadily increasing, we thought this was a great way to help the families of our school. This food pantry is available to any family who have students within the Shell Lake School District.

Here's how it works:

- The food pantry will be restocked twice a month
- Grades 7-12 students will be able to fill out an online order form for which items they will need and can pick them up in the nurse's office on Fridays.
- The online order form will be sent home via Skyward for grades pk-5 for parents to fill out. After the initial email, it will then be available on the School Website. The form will be active every Friday - Tuesday evening to order. It will be inactive Wednesday - Thursday for fulfilling orders.
- Order forms will need to be filled out and submitted by Tuesday evenings at 8:00pm
- Orders will be fulfilled on Wednesday and Thursday of that week
- Orders will be available for pick up Friday in the elementary office or can be sent home with the student. If we do not have school on Friday that week, pickup will be on Thursday.
- Families with students only in 4K will be able to pick up their groceries on Thursday in the elementary office or have sent home with that student

Once the food pantry is up and running, each parent of grades pk-6 will get an email with the order form attached. Students grades 7-12 will also get an email with the order form attached.

**In the order form, there will be questions that will need to be answered about your family. The answers to these questions are only used by Feed My People coordinators and are completely anonymous. No names or confidential information is shared. This information helps fund the Feed My People program and allows us to keep getting food for our

pantry.**




