





## **November 2024 Referendum**

On November 5, 2024, the School District of Shell Lake will ask residents to vote on a four-year, non-recurring operating referendum, authorizing the District to exceed the revenue limit.

Shell Lake is a great place to live, work, and raise a family. The support our community provides to our school district is second to none. While we are proud of our successes, we also know there is more to do to best prepare our students for their future. This operating referendum will help ensure we are able to maintain the quality and diversity of our educational and extracurricular programs that our students, families, and community have come to expect.

## Referendum Language

Shall the School Board of the School District of Shell Lake be authorized to exceed the revenue limit under Section 121.91 of the Wisconsin Statutes beginning with the 2025-26 school year through the 2028-29 school year on a non-recurring basis by the following amounts for the purpose of paying expenses related to ongoing operational costs to include maintaining educational programming, educational resources, staffing and maintenance needs as follows: \$650,000 for the 2025-26 school year, \$935,000 for the 2026-27 school year, \$1,200,000 for the 2027-28 school year and \$1,475,000 for the 2028-29 school year as provided in the foregoing resolution?





## **Shell Lake Strategic Objectives**

- 1. **Student learning**-provide students quality curriculum, instruction, and support.
- 2. Facilities-provide and maintain quality facilities.
- 3. Community engagement- welcome community involvement and input.
- 4. Human resources-attract, develop, and retain district staff.
- 5. **Finance**-provide transparent and efficient use of district resources.
- 6. Co-curricular activities-maintain a variety of quality programs for all students. These board-adopted objectives help to guide district decision-making.

### How will the money be used?

- Maintain academic programs and extracurricular opportunities for students
- · Provide instructional materials and resources
- Recruit/retain staff
- General maintenance and repair
- Maintain an adequate fund balance

### What will happen if the referendum is unsuccessful?

Without additional community support, the district would be faced with making some very difficult decisions in terms of budget reductions. These reductions would likely result in the loss of academic and cocurricular opportunities for students of all ages. These reductions would profoundly change what has made Shell Lake, Laker Proud and a district of choice for many
